If alone, read or say these prayers quietly to yourself. If with another, or in a family, someone should read the "leader" parts, and others respond. It might be suitable to find a special, quiet place at home for your prayers.

THE INTRODUCTORY RITES

Entrance Antiphon Cf. Is 48: 20 A: Proclaim a joyful sound and let it be heard; proclaim to the ends of the earth: The Lord has freed his people, alleluia.

Sign of the Cross

Leader: In the name of the Father, **Opening Prayer** and of the Son, and of the Holy L: Let us pray. Spirit.

A: Amen.

Introduction

L: As Eastertide moves on, and we approach the solemnity of the Ascension this coming Thursday, our Gospel today is once more taken from the Last Supper, and tells of the New Commandment that Jesus gives his disciples - the A: Amen. commandment of love. This love has its origins in the love of the Father, manifested in the love shown by the Son (willing to die Gospel Reading for his friends); we, like the disciples, are called to imitate the love we see in Jesus's life and death - not because we are servants, but because we are friends. Joyfully celebrating the resurrection of Jesus, we praise God's glory as we say:

Gloria

A: Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God. Lamb of God. Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Grant, almighty God, that we may celebrate with heartfelt devotion these days of joy, which we keep in honour of the risen Lord, and that what we relive in remembrance we may always hold to in what we do. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

John 15:9-17 lesus said to his disciples: 'As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments you will remain in my love, just as I have kept Father's my commandments and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my own joy may be in you and your joy be complete. This is my For our Younger Friends commandment: love one another, as I have loved you. A man can have no greater love than to lav down his life for his friends. You are my friends, if you do what I command you. I shall not call you servants any more, because a servant does not know his master's business; I call you friends, because I have made known to you everything I have learnt from my Father. You did not

choose me: no, I chose you; and I commissioned you to go out and to bear fruit, fruit that will last; and then the Father will give you anything you ask him in my name. What I command you is to love one another.'

The Gospel of the Lord.

A: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

Reflection

In recent Sundays we have been exploring our relationship with the risen Lord Jesus - we have seen ourselves as sheep of his flock and branches of his vine. But today he presents to us a wonderful new image and title we are his friends. The friendship of lesus is a gift that we cannot overvalue: like a true friends he wants to be close to us, to share our lives, our worries and our celebrations. He wants to help us we need help. friendship of Jesus explains the cross – no one could have greater love than to put themselves in the place of a friend facing danger or death. Jesus does this for us. How do we respond to the friendship of Jesus? By simply doing what he asks of us - keeping his commandments.

It's areat to have friends! They listen to us, and help us, and stick up for us, and do things for us when we are struggling. This is what Jesus wants to do for you and for me! To be our friend. If someone wants to be your friend you have to let them - we choose our friends. So we have to say "yes" to the friendship of Jesus, and let him into our lives. We do this by thinking about him, praying, and being kind.

Profession of Faith

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and The Lord's Prayer earth, and in Jesus Christ, his L: At the Saviour's command and Thanksgiving Psalm only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, Pontius Pilate. under was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. Communion

L: Loving Father, it is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, at all times to acclaim you, O Lord, you yet more gloriously, when Christ our Passover has been sacrificed. For, with the old order destroyed, a universe cast down is renewed, and integrity of life is Final Prayer and Blessing restored to us in Christ. At the L: Let us pray. Last Supper he showed the fullness of your love, as he gave his Body and Blood for his people. Even though we are not in Church, not able to receive communion today, we open our minds and hearts to vour generous love and the gift of Jesus Son. welcoming spiritually into our lives.

Pause for a moment of silent prayer and reflection.
