Diocesan Walk for our Climate

This Sunday, 10 October, there will be a Walk for our Climate from Salford Cathedral to the Laudato Si' Centre. The walk will start with a prayer then depart from Salford Cathedral at 12.30pm, arriving at the Laudato Si' Centre around 3.30pm for a short service. The walk is approximately 8.6 miles long. En route, there will be the opportunity to take time to reflect on our care for our common home.
