Dear Jesus, please help me not to care too much about what people think of me. Help me to care more about how loving and generous I am, so that I grow to be like you. Amen.



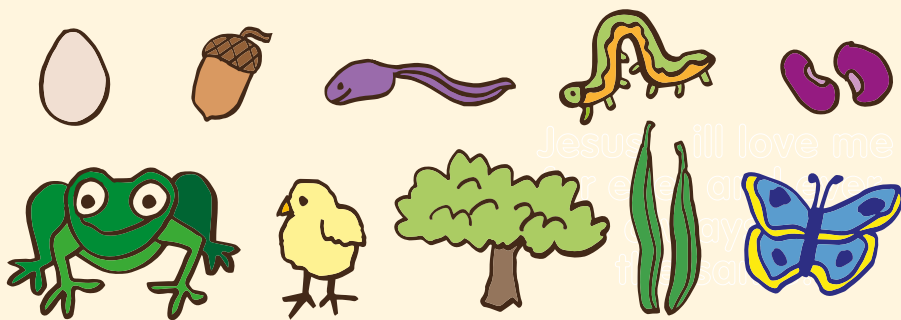

Maze

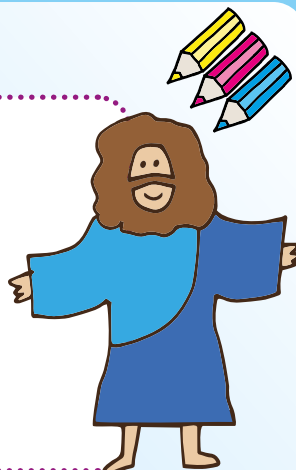
Help Jesus find his way so that he can be together with us again.



Who does God love?

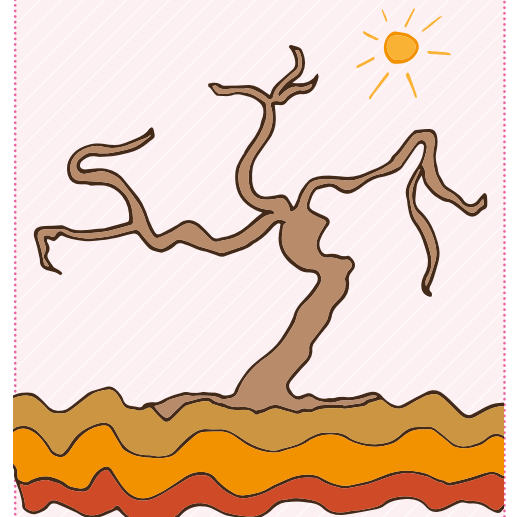
Jesus is always near us, in our hearts and the love we have in our lives.

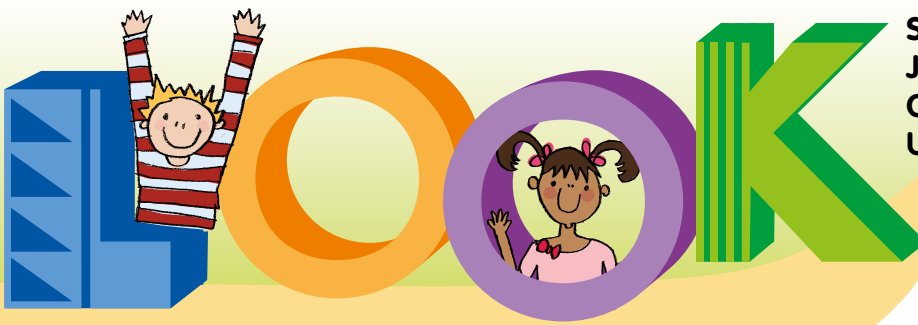
The fig tree

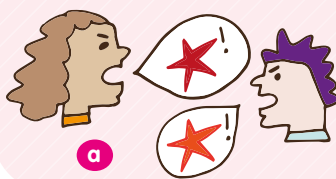


Join the dots

In a kingdom, the people do what the king asks. God wants us to live in his kingdom. **Who is doing what God asks?**

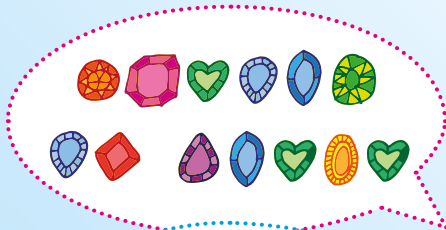


Draw a circle around the children who are living in God's kingdom.

Listening to God's truth

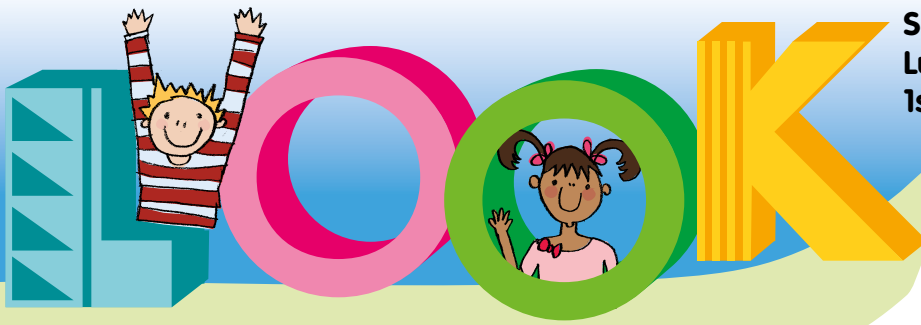
Jesus wants us to listen to him and be on the side of God's truth. Which of the children is listening to Jesus' voice?

Between these two people who are praying to God.



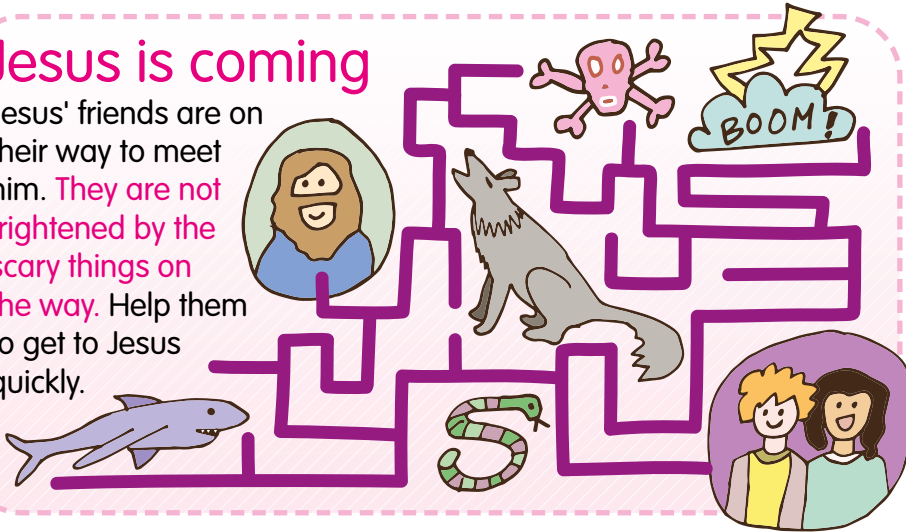
Jesus tells us so often in the Bible, "Do not be afraid"
